Research Council of Lithuania. **Philosophical Research into Cinema Art: Theoretical Assumptions, Methods, Objectives** (MIP-115/2011). Dr. N. Milerius. 2011–2013.

The project in 2013 was focused on the investigation of the territories of interest where the interaction of cinema and philosophy is at most intensive. Four territories were distinguished: 1) movement and montage; 2) becoming and identity; 3) everyday and the archive; 4) the representable and unrepresentable.

The project in 2013 was focused to explore three directions in relation to the transformations of ontology: 1) “immanent” overcoming of ontological nihilism when attempting to develop a “negative” ontology in which “nothing” carries the function of main category; 2) the analysis of E. Levinas and H. Jonas ethical investigations in relation with ontology; 3) the analysis of media as “the extensions of man” (M. McLuhan), i. e. the media enabling and forming the participation of the person in reality.

On the basis of the project investigations, there were 2 papers at the international conferences presented and 3 articles for publishing prepared.
